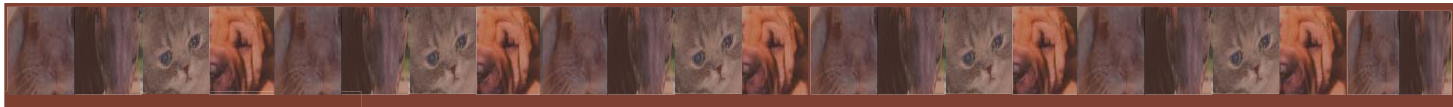

THE PHOENIX ANIMAL CARE COALITION (PACC911)
has sparked a renewed spirit of cooperation among the humane community, bringing big results.

Filling a vital community need, PACC911 brings together the many animal welfare organizations throughout Maricopa County and assists the rescue groups in four distinct ways: 1) adoption events, 2) veterinary assistance through the emergency medical fund, 3) education and 4) fundraising. An all volunteer organization, your support makes a difference enabling us to help the many groups struggling to care for and rehome abandoned and neglected pets who then become wonderful, loving companions. Come meet our special heroes that day and walk away knowing you helped save a life.

Emerg. Medical Fund (EMF)

A one-of-a-kind medical fund providing essential money to partnering rescue groups for urgent vet care. Financed solely through fundraising, over \$100,000 has been awarded in just three years, saving countless pets that have gone on to become valued family members.

Adoptathons

Over 80 rescue groups are brought together in rotating locations throughout the valley, making it easy for adopters to find a new pet. Participating groups use their matchmaking skills to ensure lifetime commitments and prevent revolving door shelter syndrome.

Fundraising

Creative campaigns like the popular "Bowlarama" provide support for groups with limited resources to raise big bucks with PACC's help. Over \$665,000 dollars were raised in the first four years through this one project alone.

Education

Unique programs like "Breaking the Chain," an art & story telling program, enlightens third graders about the sad existence of dogs living 24/7 on a chain, opening young eyes to help change a cruel and uncaring practice. Spay & neuter efforts are also prime factors of PACC's charter.
